AGA Industry Forum

As mentioned in our December 2017 NewsFlash, the 2017 AGA Industry Forum held in November was a big success with a record number of delegates attending. The Forum's theme was "Gas in a Climate of Change" and predominantly covered the Climate Change debate from a gas perspective in Australia. The forum has highlighted a number of potential issues which the gas industry faces as well as the need to collectively take action to overcome the future Climate Change related challenges.

As a result of the Forum, AGA members, including manufacturers, suppliers and associates as well as other key stakeholders have expressed an interest in forming a cooperative alliance to combat negative press on gas. As presented at the AGA Forum, gas is an essential ingredient to help achieve Australia's Greenhouse Gas emission targets up to the year 2050.
